If we receive written notice that contains substantially all of the following information, we will act

expeditiously to remove the material alleged to be infringing:

1. A physical or electronic signature of a person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right

that is allegedly infringed;

and

2. Identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed, or, if multiple copyrighted works at a

single online site are covered by a single notification, a representative list of such works at that site;

and

3. Identification of the material that is claimed to be infringing or to be the subject of infringing activity that is

located on KCTC's system or network and that is to be removed, and information reasonably sufficient to

permit KCTC to locate the material;

and

- 4. Information reasonably sufficient to permit KCTC to contact the complaining party, such as an address, telephone number, and, if available, an electronic mail address at which the complaining party may be contacted; and
- 5. A statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and, under penalty of perjury, that the complaining party is authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed.
